



Hotel: Johannesburg - May 20-23

The Garden Court Sandton City (4-star hotel)






Day 1: Tuesday, May 19 2026 NEW ORLEANS > JOHANNESBURG

Meet your group at Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport for your overnight flight into O.R. Tambo International Airport (flight times to be confirmed).





Arrive in Johannesburg. Clear customs and immigration. Grab your luggage and meet your EDU Trips Tour Guide in baggage claim.

Board your airport transfer and head to your hotel for early check-in and to drop your luggage.

Next, board your bus and enjoy a welcome tour: Visit the *Hector Pieterson Memorial* Visit the *Mandela House Museum* Visit the *Apartheid Museum*

Board your bus and depart for your welcome dinner at *Urban Mayo!* Urban Mayo offers a fresh take on the age-old tradition of cooking with fire. The menu ranges from slow and steady tagines and potjies, a curated selection of meat, chicken and seafood dishes, platters, salads and dishes to share.

Day 3: Thursday, May 21 2026 JOHANNESBURG

Visit **Chancellor House**-Nelson Mandela & Oliver Tambo's first black-owned law firm.

Enjoy free time to explore the city.

Break for lunch at group's discretion in the Maboneng District.

Visit **Constitution Hill**-site of South Africa's Constitutional Court built on top of the old prison where Nelson Mandela and many other political prisoners were held. Enjoy a guided tour of the fortress.

Enjoy dinner with your group.

Return to the hotel and retire for the evening.







Day 4: Friday, May 22 2026 PILANESBERG

Grab a quick breakfast to-go and head to **DAVINCI Hotel and Suites Johannesburg.** Board the bus and depart for *Pilanesberg National Park* to begin your safari! This is approximately a 2.5 hour drive.

Begin your safari at 9:00am for the Morning Game Drive.

Break for lunch from 12:00pm to 1:00pm.

Enjoy the **afternoon game drive** until 3:00pm and return to Pilanesberg gate, where you will get picked up to return to the DAVINCI Hotel in Johannesburg.

Enjoy dinner with your group.

Return to your hotel and retire for the evening.







Day 5: Saturday, May 23 2026 JOHANNESBURG > CAPE TOWN

Time permitting, enjoy breakfast at the hotel before checking out of your rooms. Load luggage onto the bus and board your airport transfer. Depart for the O.R. Tambo International Airport. Clear security and board flight to arrive into Cape Town International Airport.

Land in Cape Town. Gather your luggage and meet your airport transfer to bring you to the hotel. Check in and freshen up.

Day 6: Sunday, May 24 2026 CAPE TOWN

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel. Meet your tour guide in the lobby and board your bus. Board your bus to visit the **Iziko Bo-Kaap Museum** 71 Wale St, Schotsche Kloof, Cape Town, 8001

The Iziko Bo-Kaap Museum is one of the earliest homes built in the Bo-Kaap area, dating back to the mid-eighteenth century. The museum, situated in the historic area that became home to many Muslims and freed slaves after the abolition of slavery, showcases local Islamic culture and heritage.

Break for lunch at group's discretion.

Proceed to your **Team building activity - cooking class at Ginger & Lime *pending availability*** 2B Ave Disandt, Fresnaye, Cape Town, Western Cape

Your South African cooking lesson will last about 1.5 hours and help you familiarize and enjoy traditional South African cuisine over engaging conversation and lesson with the chef.



Day 7: Monday, May 25 2026 CAPE TOWN > NEW ORLEANS

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel. Check-out of the hotel and store luggage with the hotel while you enjoy a morning of souvenir shopping!

After shopping, load luggage onto the bus and depart for Cape Town International Airport.

Clear security and board the return flight home into Louis Armstrong New Orleans International Airport.
